

"Lost Lake" by Sarah Addison Allen




"Lost Lake is a love note to second chances, hopeful and entrancing, and I couldn't put it down."

Upon findina decades-old postcard from her Great Aunt Eby hidden in the attic, Kate and her eight-year-old daughter Devin leave the confines of Atlanta to explore Lost Lake in Suley, GA, and oh the adventures they have! A collection of quirky characters, all with wisdom to share, bring this story to life, and none shy away from the chance for even greater personal growth.
